Glamping at Cormiston Farm

We are not a campsite - and just have occasional camping for guests attending Spring and Summer Weddings for a limited number of days each year. Remember that it can snow in June and rain at any time, and you should come prepared for all weathers. It can be too sunny and too hot. Facilities are basic. It is a farm.

Our aim is to be as environmentally friendly as we can, with your help.

Glamping Tents are 5m bell tents with carpets, a real bed with mattress, sheet, pillows, pillowcases, 13.5 tog duvet with cover. Electricity and lighting is provided.



Parking. There is a short walk to the pitch area and you cannot park by your tent. There is a designated parking area. All parking is at your own risk, and no responsibility can be accepted for damage or loss to vehicles while in the car park. On arrival you will be allocated your glamping tent.

Trolleys are available to help carry heavy baggage. Please return these to the car park when you have unloaded.

Smoking is not permitted in the glamping tents. Smoking is permitted on the front field, but extreme caution is required when disposing of cigarette ends to prevent fire and contamination. Please do not drop cigarette ends in the field as it is grazed by sheep and horses.

No fires except in designated fire pits/stoves or by special permission. No disposable BBQs. Please ensure firepit/braziers are at least 2m from the glamping tent.

Electricity Supply is a maximum of 13Amps. Please do not overload the circuits of the electricity. All electricity supplied is from renewable sources.



Toilets and Washing Facilities There are composting toilets near the glamping area. These require all guests to sit down (rather than stand up) in order to compost the waste. There are flush toilets and washbasins with hot water in the barn, which is a longer walk. These empty to a bio-digester so do not put anything except loo paper down the toilets.

Small hand towels / paper towels are provided in the barn toilet facilities, but you need to bring your own hand towels / bath towels for showers. There are limited shower facilities at the farm

Rubbish

We provide a small number of bins etc we ask that you take your rubbish home with you, if you can, to improve recycling.
